The primary objective of the Department of English Language Teaching (DELT) is to assist prospective teachers in gaining sufficient proficiency in English and to provide them with the necessary skills to teach English as a foreign language. The İÖABD offers double major and minor programs. Those who do not have sufficient English knowledge to follow the courses after enrolling in the program are required to attend a one-year preparatory class. Professional courses, including subjects such as linguistics and foreign language teaching methods, form the core of the program to improve the English skills of teacher candidates. Elective courses provide teacher candidates with the opportunity to develop themselves in cultural and professional topics in their areas of interest.




Education

The DELT undergraduate program consists of courses related to subject knowledge, general culture, and pedagogical training. Education and training lasts for 4 years, and courses are theoretical and practical. In addition, a master's program is also offered within the Institute of Educational Sciences.


Graduates of the Faculty of Education can work as teachers, as well as in embassies and the tourism sector.
